Course Structure

Coursework: Consists of Core Courses, Major Courses, and Electives, totaling 48 credits.
Dissertation: 20-25,000 words on an applied research topic, undertaken upon completion of coursework.

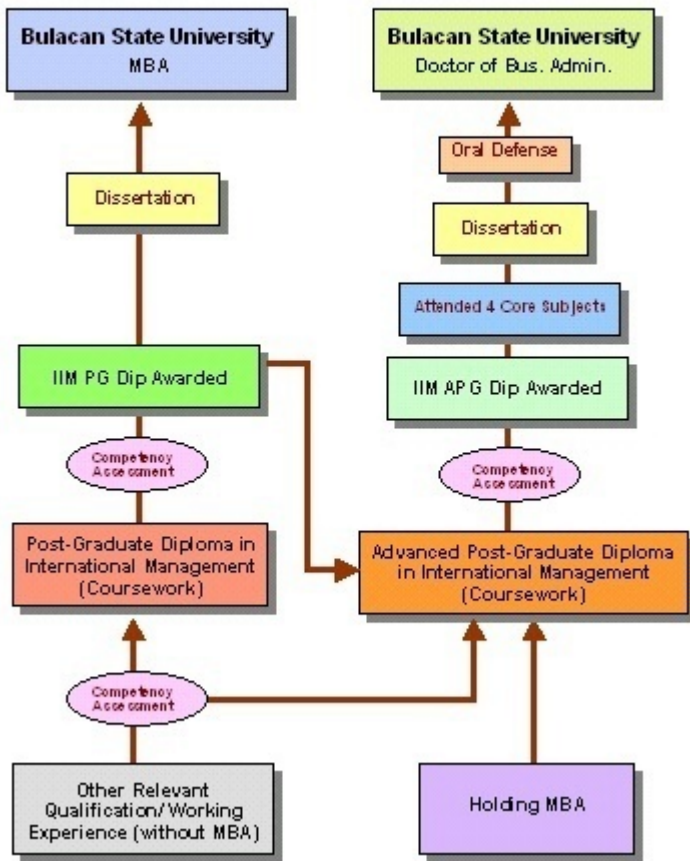
Approach

The Programs adopt distance learning/e-learning approaches supported by intensive interactive topical seminars and workshops led by seasoned professors/trainers, supported by guest practitioners. Through cyber campus and web support, candidates have the freedom of learning at their own choice, starting point, time, location and pace.

The Bridging Mechanism

Candidates learn and work through the IIM Post-Graduate Diploma or the IIM Advanced Post-Graduate Diploma in International Management. Then take on the Dissertation research under the guidance of an assigned supervisor, submit the dissertation report and present themselves for the oral defense (for DBA only). Candidates satisfying the dissertation panel's requirements are awarded MBA or DBA by the Bulacan State University of the Philippines.

Routes to Earning Your MBA/DBA Degree
From 3 to as Short as 1.5 Years



Language of Study

The Programs are delivered bilingually. Courseware is either in English or Chinese. Candidates may choose to use English or Chinese in writing up their Dissertation reports and defending their cases at the Oral Examination. (English summary is required in case of submitting Dissertation reports in Chinese. Candidates also need to arrange at their own expense instantaneous interpretation for their oral defense session.)

Duration/Completion

Starting from scratch, normally candidates will need up to three years to earn their Doctoral degree. Through due accreditation of their prior learning and competency assessment of their work experience, exemption from Coursework (Major Courses and Electives only) may be granted. The total duration may be reduced to 18 months.

Admission Requirements

For the IIM Post-Graduate Diploma, the minimum entry requirement is a first degree or equivalent. For the IIM Advanced Post-Graduate Diploma, a candidate is expected to be a Master degree holder. However, due consideration will be given to those who possess ample entrepreneurial and/or management experiences and demonstrate competencies in exploratory research and academic pursuit.

**The Degree Awarding Body:
 Bulacan State University**

The Bulacan State University (BSU) is a state-funded institution of higher education established in 1904. The history of The International Institute of Management (IIM) dates back to early 1985. A group of graduates of The Institution of Industrial Managers (UK) started the branch in Hong Kong. Membership grew steadily over the years.

In 1992 the British Institute of Management (BIM) merged with the Institution of Industrial Managers to form the Institute of Management (IMgt).
